Welcome Reggie Roberson to FMA's Board of Directors

Eaton Sales and Service's Division Manager Reggie Roberson was unanimously voted onto the Board of Directors for the Facility Manager Association of New Mexico at the General Membership Meeting in November.

Reggie started his career in Rockford, IL managing one gas station at 19 years old. At 23 he was promoted to a district manager's role, responsible for more than 25 gas stations and convenience stores. After being "laid off" at 30 (due to lack of a college degree), Reggie started his own enterprise, a petroleum service company which recognized that companies he had hired in the past had performed poorly and that he could fill that niche. Starting with two partners, Precision Petroleum Inc. was formed: no customers, just a vision. PPI eventually bought a petroleum construction company and started building new gas stations as well as performing service. The company generated \$8 million annually in



revenues and was sold. Reggie worked for the buyer for three years before moving on. In his own words: "Bored, I bought a bar and was the worst bar owner in the world."

He then started a health insurance company among other ventures. Reggie decided to get back into the petroleum services industry he loved but due to a non-compete agreement in the Illinois/Wisconsin market, he headed west. After a brief stint in Salt Lake City, UT, he found Eaton Sales & Service LLC in Albuquerque and has been here almost 9 years with the company.

Reggie has one daughter, Brittany, who lives in Rockford, IL, and a grandson, Carter. Carter has recently become a shareholder in the Green Bay Packers! Welcome our new entrepreneurial businessman who will help guide the continued success of the Facility Manager Association of New Mexico.
